Board of Health meeting minutes for July 18, 2017, Carver Town Hall, Meeting Room 3

Meeting called to order, by Mr. Borden, at 5:03 PM

Public Hearings:

On the application of Earl M. Emory, two waivers to Title 5 – allowed under Section 15.405 Local Upgrade Approval.

On parcel ID No 29-3-2-R containing 59,965 sq. ft., 10 Pleasant Street Extension.

A copy of the plan was distributed to the board members. Kevin Flaherty from Flaherty and Stefani, Inc., Mr. Emory is selling the house. Due to soil conditions we had to place the well where we did.

- 1. Section 15.405 (b) SAS to have greater than 36" of cover (up to 72" proposed) with a vent and H-20 components.
- 2. Section 15.405 (i) to allow a sieve analysis in lieu of a percolation test due to the depth of pervious material.

The board had no questions. Mr. Forgue has the sieve analysis results and they will be in the file.

Discussion:

Testing town ponds for e-coli bacteria -

Mr. Forgue - Twice (one at Sampsons and one at Crystal Lake) we've had elevated levels; follow up tests have been fine. I did get some signs made up from Signs by Design to have available to post. Analytical Balance is contracted for testing. I have obtained some testing tubes to use for a quicker turnaround, if any future **follow up** tests are needed. Mr. Mueller – Have you noticed any allergy blooms? Mr. Forgue – I have not seen any. Mr. Mueller – I think all the septic upgrades have helped.

Mr. Forgue:

- There has been no negative feedback on regulation changes and fee schedule changes.
- We have had a lot of perc tests (2-3 per week).
- We had someone apply for septic betterment and she finally has all information in place title 5 failure and 3 estimates. It took her a long time to get the estimates as contractors are very busy. It's been so long since someone has needed to fill out these forms that we are trying to locate everything. Deb is working on it. The attraction to this process is the 20-year payoff. Mr. Mueller Maybe we should put this on the town website to let people know that these funds are available. Mr. Forgue will take care of that.
