

# Carver Community Preservation Committee

## Minutes

A regular meeting of the Carver Community Preservation Committee was held on July 29, 2021 in the Carver Town Hall Meeting room 4 at 7:00 PM

Present: Robert Bentley; chairman, Cornelius Shea III, Margaret Wood, Dan Badger, and Kevin Tracey.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Bentley at 7:00 PM

Approval of the June 24, 2021 minutes was made on a motion by Mr. Shea and a second by Ms. Wood and a unanimous vote.

Mr. Bentley expressed optimism for a working relationship with the Buzzards Bay Coalition over land use, parking, and trail maintenance of the Griffith property. It has long been understood that the property is a place where fishermen park their trailers while they are on the Sampson's pond. Mr. Bentley would also like more information from the BBC about how they plan to mesh trails on the property with trails that are on adjacent town owned properties.

The Union Society project has not started yet due to scheduling issues. Mr. Moore stated that the contractor has some preliminary work and would be submitting an invoice soon.

Mr. Badger shared some photos of the work that had been completed on the Eagle project Orange trail bridge. Footings, clearing and prep work had been completed. It should be noted that this work has been volunteer service. Thank you.

There were no bills payable at this time

Mr. Badger discussed a potential future project for affordable housing involving veterans. One site seems viable at this time but with multiple partners many more could emerge

The next meeting was set for August 19, 2021

A motion to adjourn was made by Ms. Wood and seconded by Mr. Shea at 7:54 PM. The vote was unanimous to approve.
