Chapter 131, Section 40) and the Carver Wetlands Protection Bylaw, that a public hearing will be held at 7:15 p.m. on Wednesday, March 15, 2017 in Meeting Room 1 at the Carver Town Hall to hear the Notice of Intent submitted by Mr. Bob Belbin for improvements to the existing single family home; including: the replacement of the deteriorating driveway, with a drain/drywell; boulders to be installed along the upper slope of the driveway; second floor addition onto the existing house; replacement and addition of the side porch; replacement of grass from the side/back of the house; and removal of a tree for safety reasons. The proposed activities are within the 100-foot and 65-foot buffer zone to resource area bordering vegetated wetland (cranberry bog), but are outside the 200- foot riverfront area to Doten Brook. The work will require a variance from the Carver Wetlands Protection Bylaw for the work within the 65-foot buffer. The project is located at 26 Gate Street, Carver, MA, Map 19, Lot 16-A-1.
