

## Earth Removal Committee

### Minutes of 2/27/19

In attendance: Chairman J. Garretson, M. Harrison, R. Ieronimo ,  
J. Nauen, J. Shurtleff & D. Ward

Absent: None

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m.

#### Review of previous meeting minutes

J. Shurtleff motioned to approve the minutes of 10/30/18 as written  
seconded by J. Nauen. (note: M. Harrison was absent for vote)

Vote: 3 to 2 (Abstentions)

#### Discussion of Spring Site Visits

Chairman Garretson stated that SLT, Mr. Jake Arnold, Mr. Fernandes  
and Mr. Brolin site visits were completed. The Committee scheduled  
Mr. Van Johnson, Mr. Weston, Mr. Ward, Mr. Silva and Franklin Marsh  
for 3-2-19. Chairman Garretson stated that Mr. Ward and Mr. Silva were  
completed.

#### Review of Earth Removal Account

Chairman Garretson stated that he received a check from SLT and that  
Ms. Whittemore would be sending the first invoice to Route 44  
Development for approximately \$42,000 based upon the removal  
information that they submitted. A copy of the first invoice would be  
accompanied with the copy of the minutes documenting the charge of  
.25 cents per yard. Chairman Garretson stated that SLT is a commercial  
permit and is also submitting .25 cents per yard and .05 cents from the  
Plympton side. Chairman Garretson also stated that Mr. Terry Gibbs  
from Makepeace maybe opening a water hole to catch water from the  
dump side in Carver off Hammond and Farm Neck Road. He also  
mentioned a Solar Project off Cranebrook.

#### New Business

Chairman Garretson stated that the Selectmen Voted 3 to 1 to  
recommend a change of the buffer zone from 200 feet to 12.5 feet when

two property owners are in agreement. He indicated that several growers were present at the meeting. Discussion ensued regarding the "Smart Program", possible future synergy with solar and plant growth and battery powered storage. Chairman Garretson stated that the Carver Earth Removal was cited with an Award.

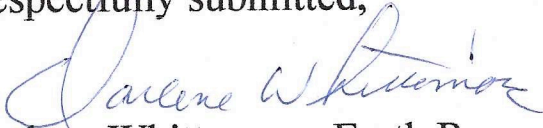
### Adjourn
