

ABSENTEE BALLOTS ARE NOW AVAILABLE FOR THE:

STATE PRIMARY ELECTION to be held on THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2016

You may vote absentee for the following reasons:

- (1) Absence from the town during normal polling hours; or
- (2) Physical disability preventing you from going to the
Polling place; or
- (3) Religious beliefs

LAST DAY TO ABSENTEE VOTE: WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7TH BEFORE NOON.

IMPORTANT:

There are presently four (4) political parties in Massachusetts:

1. Democratic (D)
2. Republican (R)
3. Green-Rainbow (J)
4. United Independent (CC)

If you have selected one of these four parties as your voter registration enrollment, you may only select that parties' ballot to vote in the primary.

If you are registered as "No Party (Unenrolled)" (U) or what is commonly referred to as "independent", you have the option of selecting any one of the four political party ballots available as listed above.

Effective in 2015, if you are enrolled in a political designation (please see list) you may also select from one of the four political party ballots available as listed above.

You may change your enrollment status by notifying the Town Clerk's Office in writing at least 20 days before an election. The last day to change your enrollment status for the State Primary is Friday, August 19th from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM.
