### 1. Approval of 11/6/18 Minutes

Motion to approve minutes by Chief Duphily 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave S.

# 2. Update and committee discussion on new plans

- Brian presented and overall view of the "campus look" of the Town with new Police Station at a slant to fit intersection, future plans of the COA connecting to the library with future parking spots, a playground between Town Hall & Library, extra spaces near the current Police Station, a picnic area near the baseball fields and a playground near the basketball courts.
- Discussion of the needs for signs at the intersection. Gates for entry and exit ways.
- Showing a public access that is separate from the EMS.
- TA updates Mary and Jim on previous plans & meetings. They were very appreciative of having background information.
- Jon P. expressed his different ideas of a "downtown village feel" with a diagram.

- Chief Duphily expressed the benefits of location for New Police Station to Mary & Jim
  - 1. Center location
  - 2. Between the schools in Town
  - 3. Easy access for response time
- Joe Sullivan acknowledged that relocating the playground was a difficult decision for the committee, but the benefits of it would be that it will be a duel function and they will be used more.
- Jim H. added that he likes the idea of making the playground part of a recreation function when near the baseball fields.
- Jon P. would like to see functioning bathrooms included in the proper locations.
- Bill H. asked if Mary or Jim have any questions so far in this process.
  - 1. Mary questioned how many phases it would take to complete this. Dave responded that recreation should come up with a priority list and then create an amount by year based off that. TA gave a rough estimate of three to four years.
- Brian then presented an updated Police Building Plan
  - **1.** Reconfiguration of intersection on Center street based off of placement of Police Station
  - 2. Intersection to be safer
  - **3.** Plan showing the now drive thru Sally Ports, a turn around, the outbuilding, gate can start off as manual then have an option to change it to automatic.
- Dave S. suggested that the carports be solar on both sides
- Brian presented an updated "Space Needs Summary" and Floor Plan
  - 1. The Drive Thru sally ports are included but reduced in size
  - 2. There are no windows in the back of the building
  - **3.** Dave S. explained that this building be mechanically uniform to other Town buildings.
- Brian presented an Outbuilding Plan -
  - **1.** Basic plan, showing mainly for storage and a physical training room.
  - 2. Discussion on adding bathrooms
- Motion to complete schematic design including elevation subject to Marc's final input by Jon P. second by Chief Duphily. Vote 6-0
