Perhaps we can utilize one of the appraisers that Jim gets. Ms. Leighton Stephen Gray said he would need a variance. Ms. Clarke We (ZBA) are meeting next Tuesday, at 7:00. Mr. Milanoski If the ZBA votes, they can do with or without the appraisal. Mr. Moore Do we need two? Mr. Milanoski You can move forward with the one that you have.
