

**REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO THE PERMITTING AND OPERATION OF
A SOLID WASTE FACILITY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO
RECYCLING, COMPOSTING OR TRANSFERRING SOLID WASTE**

PURPOSE – To provide the applicant with the following guidelines in applying for a solid waste site assignment. (Order of Conditions)

REGULATIONS – The following are the Carver Board of Health Regulations, which apply, to a solid waste recycling, composting or a transfer station:

1. The applicant must meet all Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection Regulations, as they appear in 310 CMR 16.00 and specifically 310 CMR 16.05 exemptions are no longer exempt.
2. In addition to Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection Rules and Regulations the applicant must meet the following supplemental regulations of the Carver Board of Health:
 - d. All recycling, composting and separating of solid waste must occur in an enclosed area that is designed appropriately for the intended use.
 - e. All storage and roll-off units stored outside must be covered when containing any type of material.
 - f. All fully loaded roll-off units must be removed from the site within 24 hours. There can be no accumulation of full loaded roll-off units
 - g. The perimeter property line must have at least an 8-foot high chain link fence.
 - h. Although The Department of Environmental Protection allows for the recycling of up to 100 tons per day it does not restrict how many tons of recyclables can be stored on site. The Carver Board of Health will allow only 100 tons of recyclables to be on site at any given time.
 - i. The Carver Board of Health will determine appropriate hours of operation of the facility as well as restrict operations on Sundays and Holidays.
 - j. Anyone transporting solid waste collected within the Town must obtain a Carver Board of Health permit for every truck. The cost per permit shall be \$100.
 - k. Anyone transporting solid waste in the Town will be subject to regulation by the Carver Board of Health.
 - l. The facility itself shall obtain a permit with the Carver Board of Health for \$100 per year. The facility may be subject to a technical review fee as determined during the site assignment process.

3. The applicant must meet all Carver Planning Board Regulations as they appear in the Town of Carver Zoning By-laws. Specifically, Article #4, "Special Regulations" items #4300, #4340, #4344, and #4360.
4. The applicant must secure all required permits and approvals from all other pertinent Carver Boards, (I.e., Conservation, etc.)
