TOWN OF CARVER BOARD OF HEALTH

REGULATION PROHIBITING DUMPING AND DISPOSAL OF WASTE

No person shall throw, deposit or discharge, or cause to be placed, thrown, deposited or discharged, trash, bottles or cans, refuse, rubbish, garbage, debris, scrap, waste or other material of any kind on a public highway or within 20 yards of a public highway, or on any other public land, or in or upon coastal or inland waters, as defined in section 1 of chapter 131 of the Massachusetts General Laws, or within 20 yards of such waters, or on property of another, or on lands dedicated for open space purposes, including lands subject to conservation restrictions and agricultural preservation restrictions as defined in chapter 184 of the Massachusetts General Laws.

This regulation may be enforced by any Town police officers or agents of the Town's Board of Health. Whoever violates any provision of this regulation may be penalized by a noncriminal disposition process as provided in G.L. c.40, §21D and the Town's non-criminal disposition by-law, General Bylaw Section 10.4. If noncriminal disposition is elected, then the non-criminal fine for each such violation, if not otherwise specified, shall be:

First Offense:

\$100

Second Offense:

\$200

Third and

Subsequent Offenses:

\$300

Each day or portion thereof shall constitute a separate offense. If more than one, each condition violated shall constitute a separate offense.

Whoever violates any provision of this regulation may be penalized by indictment or on complaint brought in the district court. Except as may be otherwise provided by law and as the district court may see fit to impose, the penalties for the offenses identified herein shall be as set forth in Section 6 of Chapter 270 of the Massachusetts General Laws.
