- Discussion of promoting our CCC programs, example “History of Jazz” at the COA. Janet O'Connor and Gail Nauen both attended this excellent performance. Some social media coverage was posted.
- The Carver Library has posted many summer events, especially for children. Our CCC events, including the puppetry workshop, are listed and the response has been excellent. Ms. O'Connor mentioned attending and promoting the puppetry program this August. She suggested others attend as well. Discussion of other groups (such as Scouts) were suggested for townwide involvement.

Gail Nauen volunteered to work up PR/hand outs.
