

## Carver Cultural Council Meeting Minutes


July 15, 2021      Zoom

The meeting started at 4:05 p.m.

- Review and approved minutes of 6/10/2021
- The committee welcomed new member Ellen Sordillo. We reminded Ellen that she should get sworn in by the Selectboard.

Dan Badger has secured a spot for our booth at the event. Gail Nauen volunteered to have handouts and literature on easels for our table. Our table will have the council's general info, future events and a sign-up sheet. Ellen Sordillo suggested balloons for increased traffic.
- Council's banner. It was decided to use our Administrative funds for a new banner for the table. Mary Oleskiewicz volunteered to research sign companies and design the banner with Carver Cultural (existing) logo, graphic images and possibly the Town's seal. Dark burgundy color with white lettering was agreed.
- Janet O'Connor discussed the new grant management system starting 8/20/21. Janet will forward the link for the July 29<sup>th</sup> webinar for further details. The old website will no longer be in use.
- Plans for an Acoustic music night is still being discussed. Venue at this time would be Union church in South Carver. Date in the fall TBA. Dan Badger hopes for a permanent 3 season pavillion on the grounds of the COA at Sampson's pond for an alternative music venue.
- Gail Nauen brought up 2 items regarding our grants this year. At this time, the ImagArena program at the library is postponed until further notice. A new date will have to be submitted and approved by the end of this year to qualify for this year's grant cycle. Another suggestion was to stress that although many events are at the Council on Aging, these events are open to all Carver residents.
