Old Business	No old business was available to discuss.		
New Business	Dave Siedentopf, Carver Elementary School Dave discussed various accessible features of the new elementary		
	school building, including: hard rubber on the playground, a		
	variety of accessible equipment, classrooms and bathrooms that		
	are ADA compliant, and a handicapped table in the cafeteria.		
	Mark asked if the state has assessable requirements for schools. Dave		
	stated that there is none. The school decided to make the choice.		



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	Travis asked how the evacuation plans would work. Dave said that the School has, or will have, an Evacu-Trac device, and that one is currently in the Middle-High School.
