You may vote absentee for the following reasons:

- (1) Absence from the town during normal polling hours; or
- (2) Physical disability preventing you from going to the Polling place; or
- (3) Religious beliefs

## LAST DAY TO ABSENTEE VOTE: MONDAY, FEBRUARY 29, 2016 BEFORE NOON

## **IMPORTANT:**

There are presently four (4) political parties in Massachusetts:

- 1. Democratic (D)
- 2. Republican (R)
- 3. Green-Rainbow (J)
- 4. United Independent (CC)

If you have selected one of these four parties as your voter registration enrollment, you may only select that parties' ballot to vote in the primary.

If you are registered as "No Party (Unenrolled)" (U) or what is commonly referred to as "independent", you have the option of selecting any <u>one</u> of the four political party ballots available as listed above.

Effective in 2015, if you are enrolled in a political designation (please see list) you may also select from one of the four political party ballots available as listed above.

You may change your enrollment status by notifying the Town Clerk's Office in writing at least 20 days before a primary or election. The last day to change your enrollment status for the Presidential Primary is February 10, 2016 from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM.
