

2018 CARVER DOG LICENSES NOW AVAILABLE

It is a Massachusetts General Law that all dogs six (6) months or older shall have a current rabies vaccination and be licensed in the town they reside.

Dog licensing in the Town of Carver begins in January every year.

TO LICENSE A DOG

You must have a current rabies on file in the Town Clerk's Office and kennels must be inspected by Animal Control before licensing.

- 1.) **Pay Online** at www.carverma.gov. Select "Online Payments" then "Town Clerk" then "Dog License" or "Kennel License" and follow the form.

 *NOTE: Online payments are for renewals only.
- 2.) **Check or Money Order** made out to the Town of Carver and mailed along with a copy of the rabies document and a self-addressed stamped envelope. (Please be sure to verify the date on your check.)
- 3.) Come to the Town Clerk's Office with a copy of the rabies document. We accept cash, check, money order, Master Card, Visa, American Express & Discover Cards.

FEES:

- Neutered/Spayed Dogs = \$7.00 each.
- Intact Dogs = \$10.00 each.
- Late Fee Effective March $1^{st} = 10.00 additional per dog.
- \$50.00 fine per dog for failure to license in addition to the above fees.

LICENSE YOUR DOG TODAY TO AVOID LATE FEES EFFECTIVE MARCH 1ST

Upon receipt of the check and rabies certificate, the dog license(s) and tag(s) will be mailed to you.

If you no longer have a dog please contact the Town Clerk's Office, so we may update our records. Thank you!
