



## CARVER MASTER PLAN COMMITTEE MEETING of February 22, 2016

Meeting called to order at 7:00pm

- Discussion of January Workshop for Land Use, Economic Development, Housing & Agriculture
  - Good discussion, but not a great turnout—how to increase turnout?
  - Not enough time was devoted to each topic—for discussions/questions.
  - Economic Development: Montello Street area & Edaville were not discussed.
  - Land Use was probably covered adequately.
  - Housing could have been a longer discussion. Too much time pressure.
  - Possibly a Saturday morning, instead? Can more workshops be added? Only cover 2 topics
    during the workshop? How to capture the follow-up for thoughts that came up later? Invite the
    participants from previous meetings to future meetings.
  - We didn't have time to dive deep into the topic, only hit the high points.
  - The committee members are not responsible for doing research or driving a certain section.
  - Is there any info available from the previous Master Plan update (2009-2010) that was never finished? SRPEDD was involved, but there was staff turnover & nothing was ever finalized.
  - The current process feels more collaborative.
  - SRPEDD has developed a library of all the documents that they have, but if there are other documents that are available, they will be sent to SRPEDD to be added.
  - The larger group was better for getting everyone's input on every topic. The conversation spurs other questions and thoughts.
  - The master plan committee isn't advocating for eminent domain use. A lot of planning has gone into the redevelopment of the North Carver area. The Redevelopment Authority is working to implement a specific plan for economic development. Will the infrastructure be able to be expanded? We should be planning for future growth in the area.
  - Invite "major players" to committee meeting? That may be a distraction. Possibly have them come in at the July meeting. (Makepeace, Edaville, North Carver Redevelopment, Housing Authority).
  - Transportation will be a topic for the next workshop.
