- A. Rte. 44 Development, Urban Renewal Plan
 - 1. William Sinclair noted no current updates.
- B. Service connections on Santana Way
 - 1. Mike Woollam stated Glen closed on another unit: Unit 22.
 - 2. Stephen Romano inquired when he runs out of 15 wells what's the next step?
 - i. Kevin T. Tracy noted after service connections he would stop paying the North Carver Water District Commission for closing on the units.
 - ii. Agreement was \$6000.00 plus interest for every connection, which he continues to complete.
 - iii. It was noted he continues to follow the agreement.
- C. Discussion: Well maintenance
 - 1. Mike Woollam noted well pumps were ordered for the amount of \$7,384.90.
 - 2. Mike Woollam and the Board discussed preferences to hire Paul Water Works for well maintenance versus West End Drilling.
 - i. Mike Woollam noted the Board has history of hiring Paul Water Works approximately 2.5 years ago.
 - ii. William Sinclair noted West End Drilling is local
 - iii. William Sinclair made a motion to hire Paul Water Works to pull the wells and pumps. Seconded by Stephen Romano. Voted and passed unanimously, 3-0

 - 1. Mike Woollam reported no current issues.

 - 1. William Sinclair inquired about the ongoing concerns regarding the generator for the Town installed by FM Generator Company.
 - i. Mike Woollam noted last time he spoke with Dave Siedentopf; Director of Operations and Maintenance, he wasn't sure if the generator was under warranty regarding motor quality versus company issues. There are no current issues with the generator.
 - ii. William Sinclair suggested sending an email to Dave Siedentopf regarding closure with FM Generator Company.
