CARVER PLANNING BOARD MINUTES OF August 23, 2022

Meeting was called to order at 7:10PM

Minor Modification Cont'd:

1. Jellystone Park Cranberry Acres, 20 Shoestring Road (Assessor's Maps 124 & 125 Lots 13 & 3A) Modification to Phase 2 campsites. Dan Flores with SFC Engineering, the engineer who prepared the plan addresses the board. He indicates they met with the conservation commission to amend the conditions and the commission granted the amendment on August 17, 2022, which has been recorded at the Plymouth Registry of Deeds as Book 57142 Page 216. They have also addressed the comments from Fuss & O'Neill with Plan revision dated August 12, 2022. Fuss & O'Neill responded on August 19, 2022 stating they have satisfactorily addressed all their comments. Mr. Flores then reads aloud the changes made per Fuss & O'Neill recommendations. He indicates the state's permitting is still underway and the wastewater treatment facility as well as septic have been issued a draft permit and these projects are about halfway through the period. Mr. Flores also indicates the wells are being drilled and tested. Chairman Shea asks if the wells will be in the wetlands and the response is yes. He also asks if the wells have been approved by the Board of Appeals and the response is yes. Chairman Shea asks if the ZBA has given them permits of permission and the response according to Mr. Flores that is his understanding.

Chairman Shea will accept a motion to approve the request for minor modification for Jellystone Park Cranberry Acres, 20 Shoestring Road for Phase 2 campsites. Ellen Sordillo makes said motion and it's seconded by Richard Dionne. Mr. Bott indicates he drafted a decision. Mr. Bott reads aloud a letter to the building commission, with copies to appropriate boards and town officials, stating all conditions on the project. Chairman Shea takes a roll call vote to approve said motion and Richard Dionne vote's aye, John Gaskey vote's aye, Cornelius Shea vote's aye, and Ellen Sordillo vote's aye. Approved 4-0-0.

The project will consist of landscaping with tree services home occupation.

On the application of Bridgestone Development, Inc. requesting a Special Permit and Site Plan Review pursuant to Sections 3100, 5300, 2330 and 2230 of the Carver Zoning by Law, located at Lot #3, Ricketts Pond Business Park (Off Spring Street) in Carver, MA (Assessor's Map 32 Lot 1-3) in the Spring Street Innovation Zoning District (SSID). The project will consist of the construction of two commercial buildings located at Lot #3 – Ricketts Pond Business Park located off Spring Street. The lot will be comprised of two commercial buildings with associated driveways, parking areas, closed-drainage system, septic system and utility connections. Storm water from the site development will be directed to infiltration basins designed to accommodate runoff from Ricketts Pond Business Park Definitive Subdivision.
