

Meeting Minutes for January 15, 2019 at 6:00 PM, Carver Town Hall, Room 3

Meeting opened by Mr. Sinclair at 6:00 PM

Forest Street Project:

- Update from the Executive Director
- Advertise a property in the Central Register –
- Discussion and possible vote to put back on the market –

Mr. Cole - I shared corrections with the Assessors Office; the evaluation has changed. I feel that the appraised value would not be much different from an assessed value.

The assessed value came in at \$63K which is down from \$83K. Mr. Belbin – Are we going to wait until next month on price? I'd like to do a little research.

Motion to put on Central Register and put property back on the market: Mr. Belbin

Second: Mr. Moore

Approved: Unanimous (4-0)

Ms. Leighton – This is shocking. We originally put it out for \$220K. If we advertise out there we shouldn't put a dollar amount on it. Mr. Belbin – We have to look at the properties around it too.

Mr. Sinclair – Are we going to go back to Brenda Titus? What price do we want? As Johanna mentioned, we've already had an offer of \$170K. Ms. Leighton – If you are going to advertise, don't put a price out there. I don't think going with Brenda

Titus is applicable. This needs to be a closed bid. The final price determination is the responsibility of this Board. Mr. Moore – If we put a minimum bid, we are not bound to accept that; we may accept a bid that is less. Mr. Belbin - \$63K is way too low; I'd like to do a little research first. Ms. Leighton – When Brenda initially determined \$220K what did she use to determine? Mr. Moore – I think she suggested \$200K to start; I don't think she used anything specific. Ms. Leighton – Is there an opportunity to go back and talk to previous interest? Mr. Belbin – No, you have to go to public auction/bid. Mr. Sinclair – I will put it on the next agenda.

Chairman Update:

URP -

- Discussion on inviting preferred developer to next meeting
 - o At the last couple of meetings, we've talked about getting the preferred developer before this Board; I think this is overdue. At last nights Water District Meeting; they asked about an update for URP; what if we have a joint meeting? The developer has been in front of the Water District in the past. I think a joint meeting would be great; but that would be the only thing on the agenda. Mr. Belbin I like that; we should probably consider doing this every six months or so. Mr. Moore arrived at 6:04 PM. Mr. Sinclair The Water District is having their next meeting on 2/11/19. Mr. Sinclair brought Mr. Moore up to speed on discussion. Mr. Moore is fine with doing that; Ms. Leighton is fine with doing a joint meeting as well. Mr. Sinclair I will reach out to the Chair of the Water District and see if we can coordinate.
 - Mr. Sinclair The Webby property has sold.
 - o Mr. Belbin I've been keeping track of Montello Street. When I was up there, I noticed something and also received a call about fencing being moved on Park Street. I guess a developer was looking at putting solar on there. Mr. Sinclair I believe this was the other bidder on the property. Solar on the URP is only allowed on the roofs.

Subject: Carver URP - Montello road access to be blocked and safety

Good Morning:

Based on the agreement in the proposed URP, the road access to Montello Street Plympton will be blocked by an access gate. (see attached)

The understanding is that this gate will be installed prior to construction on any of the lots in the URP. Please confirm that this will be happening?

Also, this is very important, the trucks leaving Park Avenue DO NOT STOP! This is extremely dangerous, as the wide turn these drivers take goes onto the other side of the road. Also, on numerous occasions, I personally have been cut off by the trucks exiting Park Ave, my mother has as well, and I know several residents on our street have too. The STOP sign isn't visible leaving Park Ave, and there surely is no line on the road indicating they should come to a complete stop. For so many reasons, this is extremely unsafe. Please ensure that by whatever means possible, this is rectified for the safety of the people traveling that road.
