



2018 CARVER DOG LICENSES NOW AVAILABLE

It is a Massachusetts General Law that all dogs six (6) months or older shall have a current rabies vaccination and be licensed in the town they reside.

Dog licensing in the Town of Carver begins in January every year.

TO LICENSE A DOG

You must have a current rabies on file in the Town Clerk's Office and **kennels must be inspected by Animal Control before licensing.**

1.) **Pay Online** at www.carverma.gov. Select "Online Payments" then "Town Clerk" then "Dog License" or "Kennel License" and follow the form.

NOTE: Online payments are for renewals only.

2.) **Check or Money Order** made out to the Town of Carver and mailed along with a copy of the rabies document and a self-addressed stamped envelope.
(Please be sure to verify the date on your check.)

3.) **Come to the Town Clerk's Office** with a copy of the rabies document. We accept cash, check, money order, Master Card, Visa, American Express & Discover Cards.

FEES:

- Neutered/Spayed Dogs = \$7.00 each.
- Intact Dogs = \$10.00 each.
- Late Fee Effective March 1st = \$10.00 **additional** per dog.
- \$50.00 fine per dog for failure to license **in addition to the above fees.**

**LICENSE YOUR DOG TODAY TO AVOID LATE FEES EFFECTIVE
MARCH 1ST**

Upon receipt of the check and rabies certificate, the dog license(s) and tag(s) will be mailed to you.

If you no longer have a dog please contact the Town Clerk's Office, so we may update our records. Thank you!
