Existing Utility Right of Way

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (M.G.L. Chapter 131, Section 40) and the Carver Wetlands Protection Bylaw, that a public hearing will be held at 7:15 p.m. on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 in Meeting Room 1 at the Carver Town Hall to hear the Notice of Intent; submitted on behalf of NSTAR Electric Company dba Eversource Energy; for construction of a new 115-kV transmission line between the Carver Substation in Carver and the Kingston Substation in Kingston. The proposed work will be conducted within bordering vegetated wetlands, bordering land subject to flooding, riverfront area and within the 65-and 100-foot buffer zone to said resource areas. The Project qualifies as a "limited project" under Section 10.53 (3) of the WPA Regulations.

A variance from the Carver Wetlands Protection Bylaw, Section 9.2.1.3 (3), is required for the activities within the 65-foot buffer protected under the By-law.

The project is located within the existing utility right-of-way, Carver, MA; Map 59, Lot 7. All interested parties are invited to attend.
