Even if the public raises their hands, they may not be recognized during topic discussion. All statements and questions should be directed to the Chairman during the public comment period, who will ask the appropriate person to respond, comments should be kept to three minutes or less. This is to try to keep the meeting on schedule and not run behind. This meeting will be recorded as an official record. If you wish to record the meeting in any manner you must advise the chair prior to the start of the meeting. A copy of documents used in a presentation or comments must be provided to be kept as part of the official record.
