 - Agenda Item 1 (5-10 minutes): Presentation on Open Space and Recreational accessibility in Carver. This presentation will include information on the purposes of completing an Open Space and Recreation Plan, Carver’s demographic details, most common types of open spaces in Carver, and some additional benefits that having an open space plan confers.
 - Agenda Item 2 (duration determined by visitor): Interactive physical mapping exercise. Visitors will have the opportunity to identify on a physical map where they believe that there are Open Space resources and needs; Conservation, Wildlife habitat, and Preservation resources and needs; Water resources and needs; Cultural / Historic resources and needs; Recreation facilities and maintenance resources and needs; Beautification, Recreational Programming, Bicycle / Pedestrian pathways resources and needs; and ADA access and needs. Participants mark the location of these needs using a sticker and printed out map, discussing the details of their ideas with meeting facilitators so that these can be recorded.
