Meeting Posting

On Wednesday, March 24, 2021 at 1:00 pm, there will be a Police Station Construction Meeting for the new Carver Police Station. This meeting will be held in the first floor meeting room of the Carver Public Library, 2 Meadowbrook Way. The meeting will be limited to not more than 10 participants, all participants will wear masks, and social distance as best possible. The meeting will also be remotely available via telephone or Microsoft Teams for those not wishing or unable to participate in person.

These are meetings that occur throughout the life of the project for the purpose of making sure the General Contractor, the Architect and the Owners Project Manager are all in agreement on critical elements of the project; including such items as timing, scheduling, means and methods of construction, plan coordination, potential change orders, delivery of materials, and many other relevant issues regarding the construction. These meetings would not normally be considered a public meeting, however, due to the fact that a majority of the members of the Police Station Advisory Building Committee may from time to time be in attendance could make it fall under public meeting guidelines. Out of respect for that possibility, we will post these meetings on the Town calendar, and we will post minutes of those meetings on the Town Web Site and on the Police Station Advisory Building Committee web page.
