6:01PM Executive Session – Motion: Move to go into Executive Session pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, §21(a)(3) to discuss litigation strategy with respect to a threat of litigation concerning the Town's Police Station Project, which threat was received on April 10, 2019 at 5:48 pm, if discussing the matter in Open Session may have a detrimental effect on the Town's litigating position and the chair so declares.

6:30PM Open Session discussion and possible vote regarding of Police Station project location and possibility of placing article on Annual Town Meeting warrant to seek legislative approval to build police station on site of existing playground in light of recent threat of litigation.

7:00PM Executive Session – Motion: Move to go into Executive Session pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, §21(a)(3) if discussing the matter in open session with respect to non-union negotiations and with all non-union personnel (Town Administrator's Contract) may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining position of the town if held in open session and to reconvene in open session for purpose of adjournment.

Sarcasm is generally not respectful, and the subject under consideration does not include the individuals involved in the debate. During each topic, there will be no questions from the audience. Even if the public raises their hands, they may not be recognized during topic discussion. All statements and questions should be directed to the Chairman during the public comment period, who will ask the appropriate person to respond, comments should be kept to three minutes or less. This is to try to keep the meeting on schedule and not run behind. This meeting will be recorded as an official record. If you wish to record the meeting in any manner you must advise the chair prior to the start of the meeting. A copy of documents used in a presentation or comments must be provided to be kept as part of the official record.
