Chairman Romano opened the meeting at 7:01 PM.

- Appointment: Paul Mission SRPEDD Mr. Mission went through a power point presentation on his analysis of potential traffic impacts on the proposed Spring Street Master Plan. Mr. Mission utilized the previously completed build out scenarios SPREDD had done and paid particularly attention to daily traffic counts during peak hours and the various turning movements. His conclusions were that there would be very little increased traffic on High Street with a substantial amount going onto Route 44. Mr. Mission then answered questions form the BDC. Mr. Romano thanked him and invited him to a future neighborhood meeting after the real estate analysis is completed.

- 5. North/South Carver Update Mr. Hunter updated the Board on Agway (CPS); and briefly discussed some of the outstanding issues with Decas. BDC also talked about Norfolk Power, New England Farms Gas Station and Carver Auto Sales.
