March 11, 2013 BDC Minutes

Attendance: Steve Romano, Chair; Will Sinclair, Vice Chair; and Eric Steele; Guest: Jack Hunter Chairman Romano opened the meeting at 7:03 PM.

Minutes: On a motion by Mr. Sinclair; second by Mr. Steele the minutes of January 28,
2013 were approved unanimously.

2. Buy Local Web Page – Jack noted that the Buy Carver web page is now up and running and he is looking for ideas on how to get the word out on the page! Members suggested adding it to the Towns web page; do a direct mailing to Carver businesses; contact the press; ask realtors to include it in their welcome baskets; and to ask about placing it in the next round of tax bills.

It was also suggested getting decals for participating business to place in their windows and to have a banner over Main Street. Jack will get quotes on these.

Jack also wanted the BDC's opinion on how to handle Carver residents who have a business in another town

It was unanimous from the BDC that the Web Page is only to be for Carver Businesses.
