### II. Capture Notes and Discussions

- a. Activities and Events Since Last TBSC Meeting
  - i. Several of the funding mechanisms that existed in 2011 are no longer available. There may be other options available. The TBSC will update the funding options in their report.
- b. Role of TBSC
  - i. The TBSC needs to clarify role and scope with the Selectmen.

- ii. The TBSC needs to continue to focus support for the new Fire and Police buildings and make sure money is allocated each year.
- iii. Could the TBSC bring in a consultant to assist with building planning?
- c. Status of TBSC Report
  - i. The Fire Station was originally recommended to start in 2014 based on the build of the Capital Stabilization Fund. One option to analyze is utilizing the Wrap-Around Borrow as a mechanism to reduce the yearly bond cost for the Fire Station. In 2011, the estimated cost was \$9 million with a \$600,000 per year debt for 30 years.
    - 1. Are there any grants that have opened up for the Fire Station or the Police Station?
    - 2. Are there model stations that could save money in architecture and design fees?
    - 3. Have Steve work up the financials for review.
  - ii. A Wrap-Around makes more senseto use toward the Fire Department Building now because we can make best use of it before it is no longer an option.
  - iii. Note that the town purchased land for the Police Station next to the Library.
  - iv. Note that the TBSC created a recommendation and plans for all 3 departments to move forward together. It shouldn't matter if the Fire Station starts first.
  - v. Could the town do an override to fund Capital Stabilization?
  - vi. If the town reduces CPA, that should be used for the school building. Or could this money be used for the Capital Stabilization Fund?
  - vii. Is there a municipal planner or public facilities consultant availability to survey Carver's building needs and provide recommendations?
  - viii. Members should review the Town's Master Plan. Where is it located?
  - ix. We should get the site survey for the High School. Maybe the architect has records. Maybe Randy Webster knows the original plan.
