I am pleased to inform you that the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Green Communities Division has approved an award of **\$199,984** for the following projects proposed in the Town of Carver's Green Communities Competitive Grant application.

List of projects funded:

- \$76,605, Middle/High School— LED lighting with controls
- \$57,277, Middle/High School — Air sealing
- \$4,826, Middle/High School —Door weather-stripping
- \$18,394, Fire #3— Air sealing and insulation
- \$1,155, Fire #3— Door weather-stripping
- \$14,083, Fire #2— Air sealing and insulation
- \$13,807, School Administration— Air sealing and insulation
- \$409, School Administration— Door weather-stripping
- \$4,186, Public Library— Air sealing and insulation
- \$992, Public Library— Door weather-stripping
- \$8,250, Town — Administrative assistance

The Division reviewed Carver's grant application and has determined these are viable projects that meet the eligibility requirements of our Competitive Grant program. **Please note that, due to the competitive nature of this grant program, the use of these funds is restricted to the specifically-approved projects listed above.**
