COVID 19 VACCINATION UPDATE

The state has approved vaccination sites across Plymouth County and the State to assist with those eligible to receive the vaccine as part of the Statewide Vaccination Plan in Phase 2. **Individuals in [Phase 1](#) & [individuals 75+](#) can get the COVID-19 vaccine now.**

Residents may also call 211 to access guidance from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in scheduling vaccinations.

It is recommended that residents plan to travel to the Mass Vaccination Clinic at Gillette Stadium located on 1 Patriot Place in Foxborough, as they have many available appointments daily that go unfilled and are a primary reception site of vaccine doses from the state compared to local communities/pharmacies.

Note that appointments are based on the vaccine dose availability at the four (4) local clinics listed above, and currently there is a shortage of the doses at these clinics.

Residents who require assistance to schedule appointments online at any of the above locations may visit the Carver Public Library during their regular business hours of Mondays 10:00-4:00 and Wednesdays 10:00-6:00. Appointments for help with scheduling vaccinations are recommended, but not required, and may be made by calling the library at 508-866-3415.
