Thursday March 24th 2020 – Last day to withdraw nomination papers.

Monday April 6th 2020- last day to register new voters or to make changes to your voter registration for Town Election and Town Meeting.

Tuesday April 14th 2020- Annual Town Meeting held at Carver Middle High School
