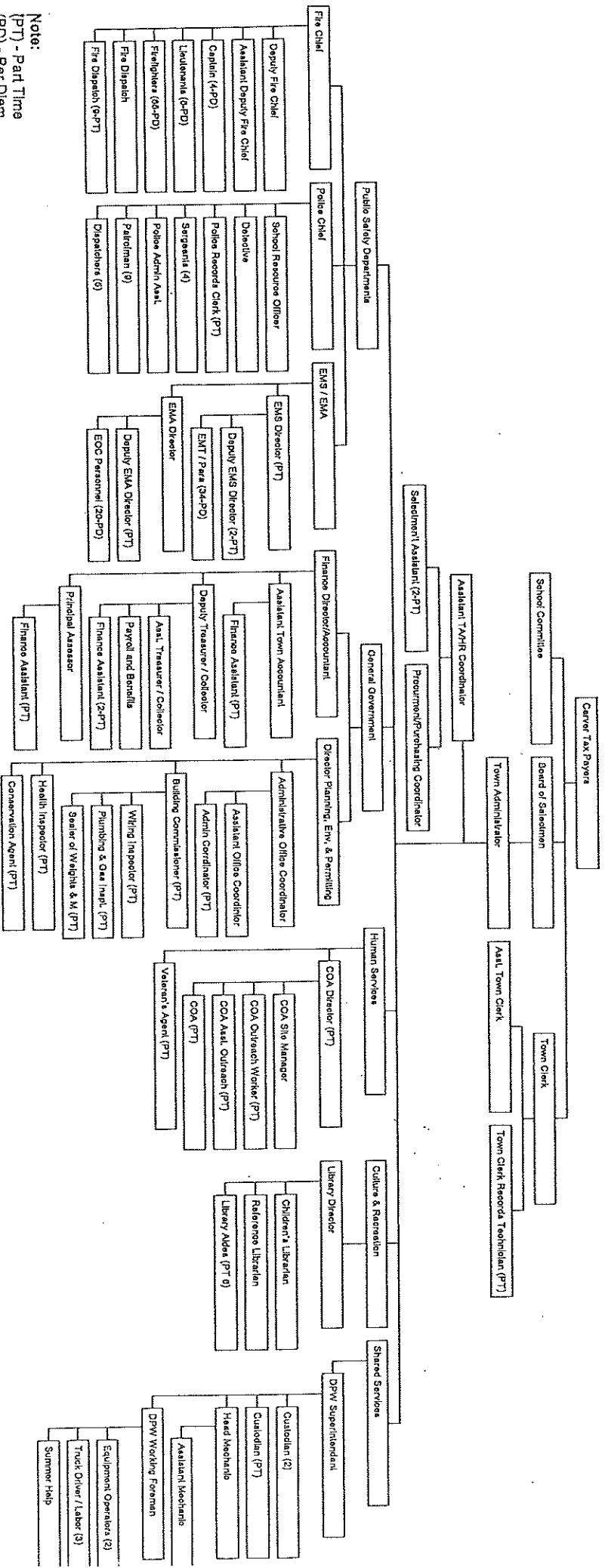


Town Wide Organization Chart FY17 - APPENDIX A
