SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT

Plymouth, ss. To either of the Constables of the Town of Carver, County of
Plymouth in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts

GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Carver qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Carver High School, in said Carver, on Monday, May 17, 2004 at 7:30 O'CLOCK P.M., then and there to act on the following Articles, namely:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds in the treasury the sum of Twenty-One Thousand Two Hundred Thirteen Dollars and Eighty-Seven Cents (\$21,213.87) **unpaid bill** under the provisions of Chapter 240 section 7 of the Acts of 1989, or take any other action relative thereto:

Norfolk Ram Group, LLC \$21,213.87

(By the Board Selectmen)

Article 2. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate or transfer from available funds the amount of \$35,000 for the purpose of continuing the environmental cleanup of 99 Main Street, or take any other action relative thereto.

(By the Board of Selectmen)

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Ambulance Receipts Reserved for Appropriations Account the amount of \$9,000 (nine thousand dollars) to pay for the final year of a four year bond for the purchase of an ambulance, or take any other action relative thereto.

(By the Treasurer)

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of purchasing and equipping one four wheel drive marked police cruiser, said expenditure to be under the direction of the Selectmen and Chief of Police, or take any other action relative thereto.

(By the Police Department)

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds or borrow the sum of Eighty-Eight Thousand (\$88,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of purchasing and equipping three marked police cruisers, said expenditure to be under the direction of the Selectmen and Chief of Police, or take any other action relative thereto.

(By the Police Department)

Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds amounts recommended by the Board of Selectmen to supplement specific budget line items appropriated at the 2003 Annual Town Meeting, or take any other action relative thereto.
(Board the Board of Selectmen)

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the several places designated by vote of the town fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meetings.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, at the time and place of meeting aforesaid.
