SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT

Plymouth, ss. To either of the Constables of the Town of Carver, County of
Plymouth in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts

GREETING:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Carver qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Carver High School, in said Carver, on June 12, 2006 at 7:05 O'CLOCK P.M., then and there to act on the following Articles, namely:

Article 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand (\$35,000.00) Dollars from the Board of Health's trash collection fees receipts reserved for appropriation account (so-called Financial Assurances Mechanism) for the purpose of funding monitoring and maintenance of the North Carver Landfill, or take any other action relative thereto.

(By Board of Selectmen)

Article 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds amounts recommended by the Board of Selectmen to supplement specific budget line items appropriated at the 2005 Annual Town Meeting, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) for the purpose of replacing the 1994 Chevrolet Astrovan for the Animal Control Department, said sum to be expended by the Board of Selectmen, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred (\$15,500.00) Dollars to pay the Department of Environmental Protection for regulatory fees on property located at 99 Main Street. Said sum to be expended by the Board of Selectmen, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand, Five Hundred Seventy-Four Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$35,574.20) to pay Norfolk Ram Group for environmental cleanup services on property located at 99 Main Street. Said sum to be expended by the Board of Selectmen, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to rescind Article # 4 of the Special Town Meeting held June 16, 2003 and vote to transfer from the Cranberry Village Water Fund

Free Cash the sum of Twenty-Eight Thousand (\$28,000.00) Dollars to cover one half of the town's share of the water fund reconstruction.

And you are directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the several places designated by vote of the Town fourteen days at least before the time of holding said meetings.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, at the time and place of meeting aforesaid.
